

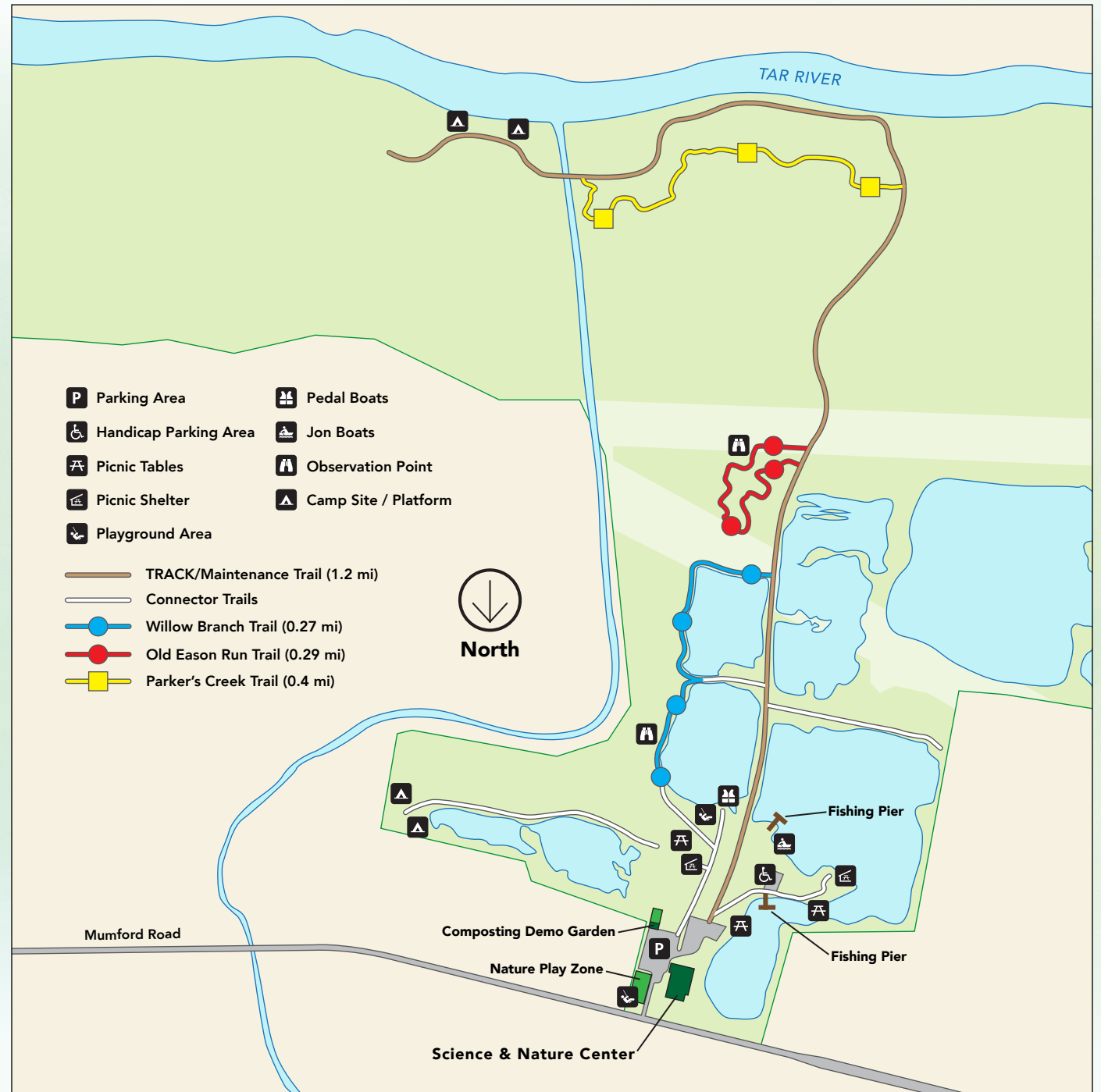


Visiting River Park North

Recreational and educational opportunities abound at Greenville, North Carolina's premier science and nature facility, River Park North. Located on 324 acres with 1.2 miles of frontage on the Tar River, River Park North includes 250 acres of rich bottom land forest, 50 acres of small ponds, and over 20 acres of open grassland.

Visitors are encouraged to take advantage of the wide variety of recreational activities that River Park North has to offer, such as:

- Fishing (5 ponds & 2 piers)
- Rental fishing boats & kayaks
- Pedal boating
- Camping platform & pads
- Nature Play Zone
- Hiking trails
- Fossil pit
- Picnic shelters with grills
- Sand volleyball court

Visit the Walter L. Stasavich Science & Nature Center!

The Walter L. Stasavich Science & Nature Center houses a 70-seat theater along with a variety of exhibits including a turtle touch tank, Waterfowl of the Atlantic Flyway, a 10,000 gallon freshwater aquarium, live snake exhibits, a discovery room, North American Wildlife diorama, and a shell exhibit.

Park Rules:

- All dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6 feet.
- Alcohol and drugs are prohibited.
- Swimming is prohibited.
- A valid state and park fishing permit is required for all guests 16 and older.
- Please do not cut or remove vegetation or wildlife.
- Park gates are locked promptly at closing.
