Travel and accommodation will be the responsibility of the resident, however, funding for up to \$1,000 for round-trip travel and \$350/week accommodation is available through REAP to offset costs to residents. Visit rccbc.ca/reap for information on funding.



RESIDENT LOCUM MATCHING

The Resident Locum Matching Service is an optional program available to family medicine residents at UBC interested in rural medicine.

The program is supplemental to a resident's current rural training opportunities and is intended to be completed during their elective time.



Our program matches residents who are looking for extra rural training with practicing rural and remote locums.

Successful applicants will be paired and work with a rural locum doctor in a one-to-one preceptorship for a length of rotation up to four weeks.
