1. FAMILY SNOW SCULPTURE CONTEST (ALL DAY) Free! Sponsored by the Elkford Lions Club.

Step 1: Assemble your team and register by February 12 at 4 p.m. by calling 250.865.4010 or emailing events@ elkford.ca. Maximum of eight teams.

Step 2: Think of a sculpture that matches this year's theme: Winter in the Wildness. Find several piles of snow at Riverview Park (near the green bucket) ready to go whenever you are, starting Friday morning, and you have until Sunday, February 16 at 3 p.m. to complete your masterpiece for judging. Your team is responsible for all supplies required to create your sculpture. Cash prizes for first, second and third place will be awarded. Spectators welcome and encouraged!

Important rules and guidelines: Sculptures must be at least two feet tall, must have some colour, must be made of snow and must include a sign stating your team's name and what you have built for judging purposes.

2. SHINNY HOCKEY (NOON TO 2 P.M.)

Regular admission rates apply. Offered by the District of Elkford. All ages welcome, but those 12 years and under must be accompanied on the ice by an adult/guardian who is 18 years or older. Helmets are mandatory.

3. WINTER IN THE WILD POOL PARTY (12:45 TO 3 P.M.)

Regular admission rates apply. Offered by the District of Elkford. Pool toys and prizes! Children under the age of six require a guardian in the water and within arms' reach of them.

4. ZAMBONI UNVEILING (3:30 TO 4 P.M.) & PUBLIC SKATING (4 TO 6 P.M.)

Step 2: Your team creates your toboggan in advance using only cardboard, tape, glue and paint (and maybe some stickers for extra horsepower). Your team is responsible for all supplies required to create your toboggan. Cash prizes for first, second and third place will be awarded. Spectators welcome and encouraged!

Step 3: Show up at the race:

- 10:45 to 11:15 a.m.: toboggan and team check-in. 11:15 to 11:30 a.m.: safety briefing and rules overview. 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.: toboggan races. 12:30 to 1 p.m.: awards/prizes and closing.

Important rules and guidelines: Open to all ages with categories for youth, teens and adults. Children under ten must be accompanied by a parent/guardian on-site (parent/guardian does not have to race). Toboggans must be made from cardboard, tape, stickers and paint only – no metal, wood or other mate-rials permitted. Bottom of toboggan must be bare cardboard. All participants must bring and wear their own helmets. Extras are not available. No helmet = no racing.
